

## Changes introduced in CDS release 4.2.0

CDS Change	Declaration Completion Instructions
Meursing Codes in DE 6/16.	When required by the NI Online Tariff, a Meursing code must be entered as an additional code in DE 6/16. Only one Meursing code may be entered for a single commodity code. If a Meursing code is required but none is entered the declaration will be rejected. All applicable taxes and duties must be accounted for on the declaration.
Tax base units required for certain commodity codes when using OVR01.	When using AI Code OVR01 as part of a manual duty calculation, the correct tax base unit should be declared in DE 4/4 for each applicable tax type being manually calculated.
New AI Code added to CDS code list.	Traders to be able to declare Additional Information (AI) code DCM01 in DE 2/2 on import declarations when advised by HMRC. Appendix 4 will be updated in due course.
Additional Information code 00600 is no longer required on a B1 MOU declaration.	When declaring Additional Procedure Code 1MU on a B1 MOU declaration, AI Code 00600 is only required in DE 2/2 when goods are bulked under a single heading.
Additional Information code GEN30.	AI Code GEN30 is not required in DE 2/2 when declaring Additional Procedure Codes D03, D05, D24 and D27.
For Export and Customs Clearance Requests, Container ID can now be declared at both item level and header level in DE 7/10.	<p>For all Export declarations and Customs Clearance Requests, Container ID can be added in DE 7/10 at both Item and Header level.</p> <p>Where items on the declaration are packed into different containers, DE 7/10 will need to show individual container numbers at item level.</p> <p>Where the seal numbers declared in DE 7/18 require alignment with container numbers, the container numbers must also be declared at header level.</p>
Additional Procedure Code 1PF cannot be used with EIDR procedures.	Additional Procedure Code 1PF can only be used where declaration type A or D is declared in DE 1/2. This Additional Procedure Code cannot be used with EIDR.
New Authorisation codes available for use in DE 3/39.	<p>New authorisation type codes ATR, AOR &amp; AVR added to Appendix 6 for use in DE 3/39.</p> <p>The appropriate Authorisation Type code should be used when the corresponding document code 1ATR, 1AOR or 1AVR is declared in DE 2/3.</p>

New Document Codes added.	New Document Codes have been added to Appendix 5A.
Country of Origin codes.	Country of Origin in DE 5/15 or 5/16 is only required when mandated by the declaration category, Procedure Code, or Additional Procedure Code.
Net Mass.	Net Mass in DE 6/1 is only required when mandated by the declaration category, Procedure Code, or Additional Procedure Code.
Deduction Code BC removed from Appendix 10.	When submitting an Import declaration, deduction code BC is not a valid code for use in DE 4/9.
New Goods Location Codes.	New Goods Location Codes added to Appendix 16.
