CSE Authorisations with Procedure Code 2300	Exports	<p>Following trader feedback, CSE-authorized traders can now use their CSE authorisation when goods are temporarily exported for return of goods in the unaltered state for the purposes of claiming Returned Goods Relief under Procedure Code 2300.</p> <p>To use the CSE authorisation with Procedure Code 2300, the following data elements must be completed:</p> <p>Data Element 1/1: EX or CO Data Element 1/2: A Data Element 1/10: 2300 Data Element 1/11: 1CS, in addition to any other applicable APCs Data Element 2/3: document code C676 followed by the CSE authorisation number Data Element 3/39: Authorisation type CSE followed by the EORI of the holder of the CSE authorisation DE 5/23: the Goods Location Code for the approved CSE premises</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: APC 1CS is a temporary workaround and is not published in the Declaration Completion Instructions.
